

September 24-30, 2020 - CAMPFIRE Church Outline

Before Meeting:

- Give a personal invite to group members.
- Download the video and/or familiarize yourself with the link (parksidechurch.ca/sept24).
- Set-up room, sanitize, get video ready.

At Meeting:

- 1. Welcome & Attendance (record on paper or see email sent 10 minutes before meeting start time to access attendance roster online). If someone is missing from that list, notify the pastor that calls you the next day after.
- 2. Go over safety protocols and venue instructions (i.e. bathroom location, stay 2m apart, etc.)

3. Announcements

- a. Thank you to the guys that helped last Saturday even in the middle of the rain to spruce up our church grounds.
- b. Thank you to the women that were able to bless Lexi Neufeld at her wedding shower.
- c. This coming week we're going to honour Mrs. Kim for 25 years of service at Parkside as she retires from leading our Children's Ministry - we'll get to watch that at next week's Campfire, but we also want those with kids to save the date - Saturday, October 31st 1-3pm - we are having a Hootenanny for our kids - Mrs. Kim is going to be there and it will be an opportunity for our kids and parents to say thank you in-person to Mrs. Kim!
- d. Also next Campfire we'll be participating in communion in our gatherings.
- e. Please give your tithe and offerings at parksidechurch.ca/give or send an etransfer to <u>donations@parksidechurch.ca</u>. Thank you!

- 4. Ask someone to read Isaiah 40:28-31.
- 5. In reflection of that Scripture, take a moment and wait on the Lord... ask for 1 or 2 to lead out in prayer to open your time together.
- 6. Let's join in song to worship our God and receive a message from Pastor Clint as well as witness a water baptism! [Play video of worship/message/baptism].
 - a. Please note: the audio for the worship and the message has tiny little glitches throughout. We're sorry for the distraction this will cause, but trust we'll all be able to keep focused and open our hearts to God in one accord. (We've figured out how to solve the audio issues so this should be the last time.)
- 7. After the video is over... "What did the Lord speak to you in this gathering that might encourage us and/or build your faith to speak out loud?" [Members share; you might ask if anyone would like prayer for healing or another matter; facilitate the sharing and praying].
- 8. Closing Prayer or Scripture

After the meeting:

- Debrief with your co-host.
- Journal any thoughts, prayer requests, challenges or successes, etc.
- Ensure attendance is entered in app or on computer.
- Connect with a pastor the next day to debrief on the meeting.
